# Our beautiful parks

The Arun area is fortunate enough to be blessed with many beautiful parks, recreation grounds, play areas and sports sites, offering a wide range of outdoor facilities to our residents and visitors. **Bersted Park Art Trail,  
Lakeside Avenue, Bognor Regis**

Bersted Brooks Art Trail, has been installed within the Bersted Park public open space.

Bersted Park is a 26-hectare site and also features a trim trail, a lake, sports pitches with community centre, fields of wildflowers, lightly managed wild areas and magnificent views of the South Downs.

**West Park,  
Silverston Avenue, Aldwick**

Located on the seafront, next to Marine Park Gardens, West Park is a great multi-use open space with a variety of play equipment suitable for a wide range of ages from babies to older children. Featuring large open grassland, perfect for dog walking or picnics with the family.

**Brookfield Park, Marlborough Place Estate,  
off Worthing Road, Littlehampton**

Brookfield park offers families and dog walkers a place to walk around and enjoy the wildlife and play facilities. Features include a well- established lake, wildflowers meadows, a woodland pine walk, grassland and play areas including a multi-use games area.

**Mewsbrook Park,  
Sea Road/Hendon Avenue, Littlehampton**

Open 365 days a year; cafe open all year round, Littlehampton miniature railway and boating lake open seasonally and for special events.

A rich, colourful mixture of permanent and annual planting and has a range of facilities to keep visitors of all ages entertained.

**Marine Park Gardens,  
Marine Drive West, Aldwick**

Situated on the seafront, Marine Park Gardens dates back to the 1930s and features stunning herbaceous plants and outstanding bedding displays for all seasons. In addition, the park is home to many original architectural features, including an ornamental fountain.

**Hotham Park,  
High Street/London Rd, Bognor Regis**

Conveniently located close to the station, town centre and Butlin's, Hotham Park is where the founder of Bognor Regis, Sir Richard Hotham, built his home in 1792. Major restoration work has taken place in the park following a £2.2 million grant award from the Heritage Lottery Fund.

**Marina Gardens,  
St Catherine's Road, Littlehampton**

Close to both the centre of Littlehampton and the seafront, Marina Gardens boasts mature tree and shrub planting, along with a long, well-stocked, raised herbaceous border and bright beds of annual flowers. Ideal for a picnic or simply a break from shopping.

**Norfolk Gardens,  
Sea Road/South Terrace, Littlehampton**

Located on Littlehampton seafront and offering a fantastic range of activities to keep the family entertained.

Cafe, miniature railway (running to Mewsbrook Park), tennis courts, pitch and putt, Adventure Golf, Bowling Green, public toilets.
